ALLIED HEALTH ASSISTANT SESSIONS

Key Responsibilities:

- Implement therapeutic interventions and activities designed to enhance clients' cognitive, sensory, and psychosocial functioning.
- Facilitate group therapy sessions and workshops to promote social interaction, communication skills, and community integration.
- Conduct functional assessments and document clients' progress, observations, and treatment outcomes accurately and timely.
- Assist in the setup and maintenance of therapeutic equipment and assistive devices to support clients' rehabilitation goals.
- Communicate effectively with clients, families, caregivers, and interdisciplinary team members to ensure coordinated care and continuity of services.
- Participate in team meetings, case conferences, and professional development activities to enhance clinical knowledge and skills.
